Achievements

Didactic materials for the Jolly Phonics method are included in the list of recommended textbooks, for the purchase of which the Ministry of Education of the Slovak Republic provides financial resources



Throughout a period of four years, we have been able to work together to increase the educational outcomes of pupils in English in primary education through the training of teachers using the Jolly Phonics method and the modern educational provision of textbooks and aids. Despite the changing conditions related to the pandemic, we COVID-19 the had opportunity to gain experience in applying the method in present as well as in online education.



We continue with expert training for teachers who use the Jolly Phonics method, and support them in the further professional growth and effective application of the Jolly Phonics method in practice.
